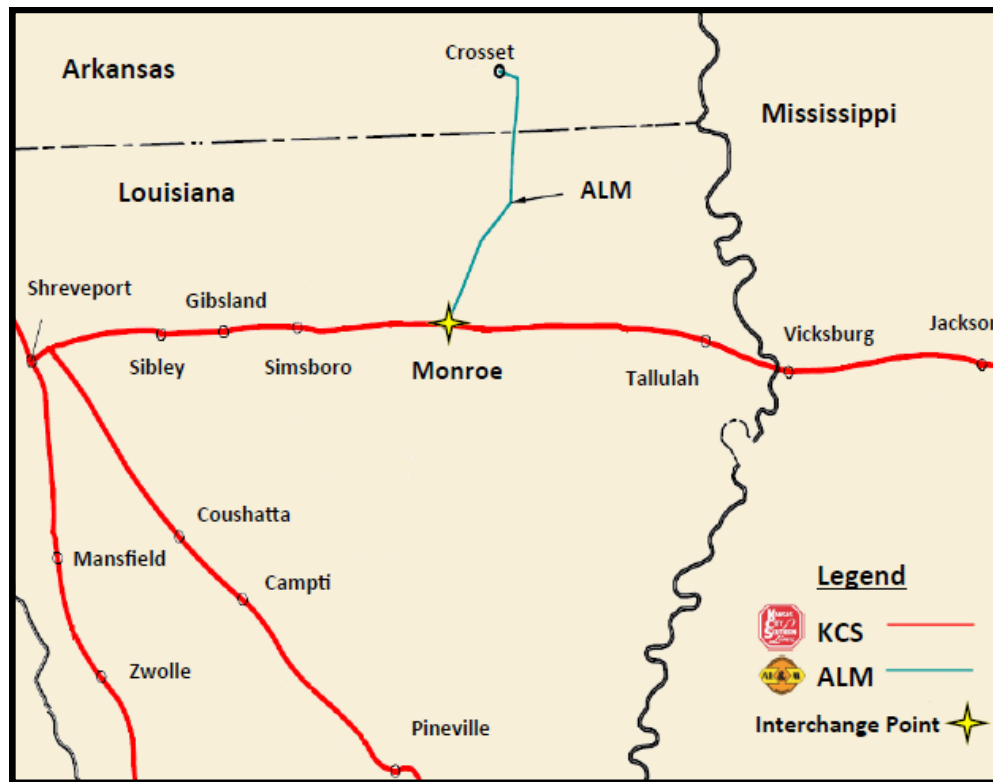

On July 20, 1906 the Arkansas Louisiana and Gulf Railway (AL&G) was chartered to build a line from Monroe, LA to Pine Bluff, AR. The line was completed from Monroe to Hamburg, AR and from Rolfe Jct. to Crosset, AR and opened October 1, 1908. On May 29, 1913 the company was reorganized in December, 1915 as the Arkansas & Louisiana Midland Railroad (A&LM). In 1991, Georgia Pacific organized the Arkansas, Louisiana and Mississippi Railroad (ALM) and purchased the A&LM. The Genesee and Wyoming Inc. then purchased the ALM from Georgia Pacific in 2004.
