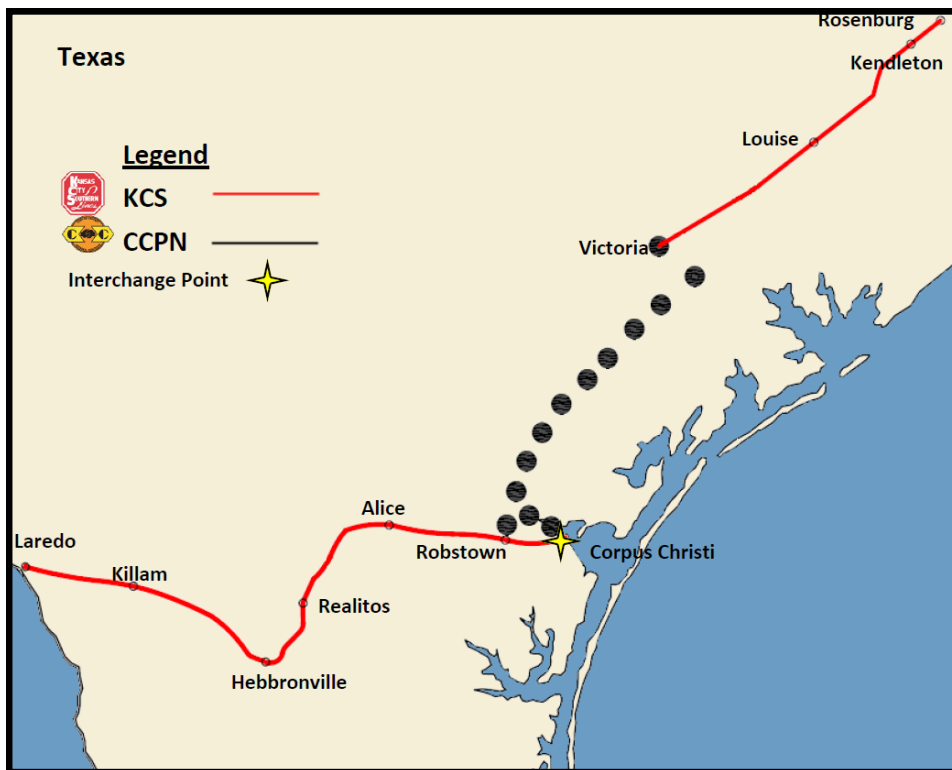

In 1924, the CCPN was created to accommodate the heavy bulk freight cargo traffic for the Corpus Christi Port.. The Port Authority had the intention of keeping freight rates competitive, so they only allowed 3 railroads to handle the traffic in and out of the Port. These 3 railroads are the UP, BNSF and the KCS. The CCPN was acquired by the Genesee & Wyoming Inc. in 1997.
