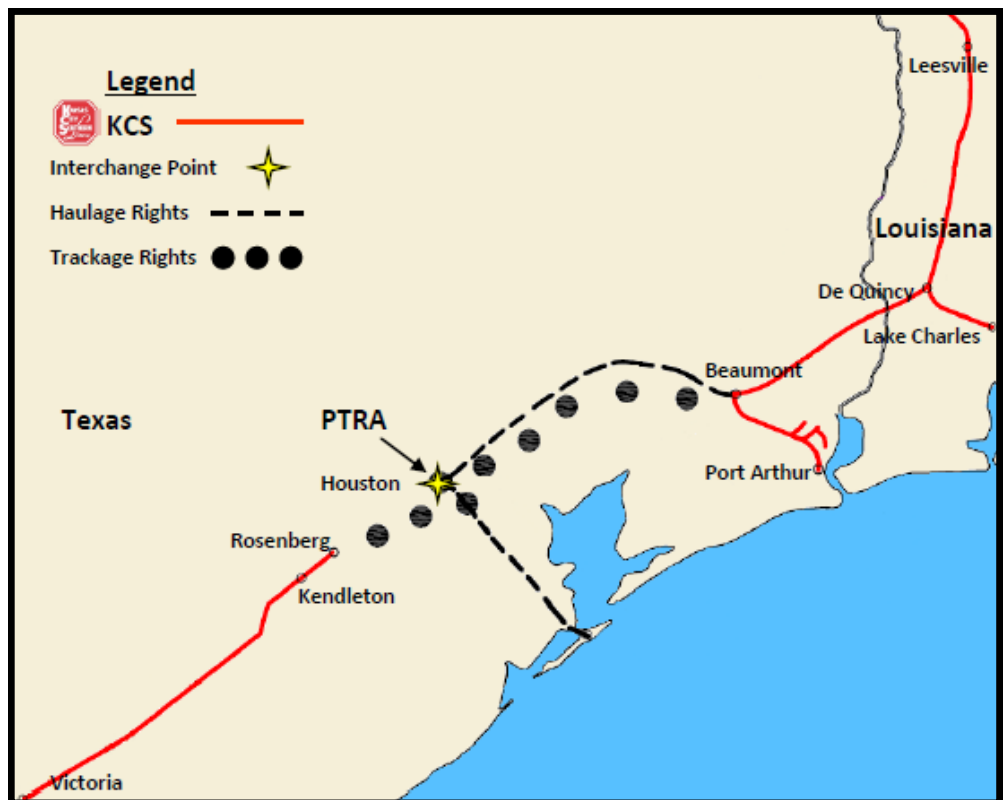

The PTRA is not just a shortline, but an association of 18 railroads that had access to Houston in 1924. This association was created to give all the railroads equal access to the Port of Houston. Before 1924, only 3 carriers had access to the Port: International-Great Northern Railroad Company, Southern Pacific Lines, and the Houston Belt and Terminal Railway. Currently, the only railroads on the voting members Board of Directors are the KCS, UP and the BNSF.
