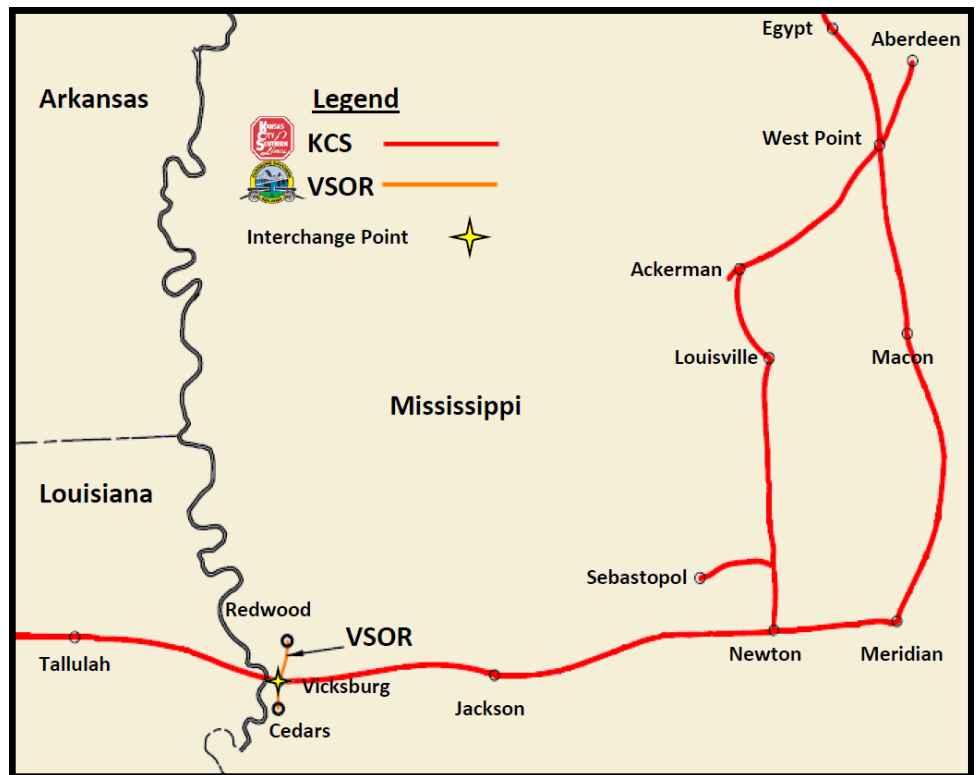

This line was built in 1884, which was part of a mainline between Memphis and New Orleans. It was then owned by the Illinois Central Gulf Railroad (IC). The IC sold portions of the track near Vicksburg along with the present Meridian Speedway to the Mid-South Rail Corp (MSRC) in 1986. KCS absorbed the MSRC in 1993. The VSOR started operations on January 8th, 2006 on what used to be known as the Redwood Branch. This line was acquired by Watco Companies through a lease agreement with the KCS and that is when the VSOR was created.
